
Mission statement: Make our homes a little cozier with privacy preserving ambient intelligence



Step 1


Run Al locally. Train on local data. Share models, not data.

Step 2


Local storage with optional remote back-up. Transparency and full user control.


Step 3

P2P communication with user mobile device. Minimize man-in-the-middle issues.









Architecture of Popular Brands




